## Target 2060 Fund added to lineup

We are pleased to announce the July 1 launch of the *Wells Fargo Advantage Dow Jones Target 2060 Fund*<sup>SM</sup>. With this addition, the suite of *Wells Fargo Advantage Dow Jones Target Date Funds*<sup>SM</sup> will continue to serve the retirement needs of a full spectrum of investors.

The target date represents the year in which investors may likely begin withdrawing assets. The funds gradually seek to reduce market risk as the target date approaches and after it arrives by decreasing equity exposure and increasing fixed-income exposure. The principal value is not guaranteed at any time, including at the target date. The Target 2060 Fund is designed to meet the needs of investors who are just entering the workforce and those who seek retirement income beginning around the year 2060.
